

INSTRUMENT OF GOVERNMENT

1. The name of the school is **Shurdington Church of England Primary School**
2. The school is a voluntary controlled school
3. The name of the governing body is **"The governing body of Shurdington Church of England Primary School"**
4. The governing body shall consist of:
 - 3 parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 staff governor
 - 1 headteacher
 - 2 foundation governors
 - 3 co-opted governors
5. Total number of governors **11**
6. Foundation governors shall be appointed by Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education after consultation with the Shurdington, Badgeworth and Witcombe Parochial Church Councils.
7.
 - (a) the holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex officio:

The principal officiating minister of the ecclesiastical parishes of Shurdington, Badgeworth and Witcombe.
 - (b) The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of an ex officio foundation governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex officio foundation governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or there is a vacancy in the office by virtue of which the governorship exists, or has been removed from office under regulation 21(1) of the Regulations.
8. The Archdeacon of the Archdeaconry in which the school is situated shall, on behalf of Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education, be entitled to request the removal of any ex officio foundation governor and to appoint any substitute governor.

9. A Trust exists which relates to the school, the Trustees being Gloucester Diocesan Board of Education.
10. Shurdington Church of England Controlled School has a Christian foundation, which it seeks to promote by providing high quality educational opportunities to all members of the school community. It encourages this through collective worship and the values and ethos of a curriculum which seeks to offer opportunities and experiences to promote pupils' spiritual and moral development and to provide a basis for their lifelong learning.
11. This instrument of government comes into effect on 1st June 2015.
12. This instrument was made by order of Gloucestershire County Council

on12th May 2015.....

13. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the headteacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the appropriate religious body.
