Uniform Policy

Shurdington Church of England policies are written in the spirit of Christian values

The Governors and staff believe that the wearing of school uniform:

- Promotes equality
- Makes an important contribution to raising standards
- Is a social leveller
- Creates a strong and recognisable school identity
- Provides protection from peer pressure
- Aids child safety on school visits

Required Clothing

Grey or black trousers, shorts, skirt, pinafore dress or a light blue gingham dress (generic items acceptable)

White polo shirt, shirt or blouse (generic items acceptable)

Branded sky blue sweatshirt or cardigan

All branded school wear can be purchased online or in store from Monkhouse although we also have second hand items in school for sale. Please contact the school office for more information.

FOOTWEAR Sensible plain socks. **Shoes** should be black, flat (no higher than 2cm), sensible and should ideally be closed for comfort and safety. Children may also wear sensible, black boots.

A hat should be provided for hot, sunny days.

The following are unacceptable (and if worn children will be asked to change into something else which will be provided for them to wear at school):

- ***Jogging bottoms and sports clothing including leggings.***
- ***Trainers.***
- ***Hooded sweatshirt.***
- ***Crocs, flip flops etc.***
- ***Jeans.***
- ***Football strips for PE.***

Reasonable adjustments can be made if there is an identified additional need. If needed, please speak to our school SENDCo or Headteacher.

PE Kit

White or pale blue T-shirt
Black or navy shorts
Black pumps
Trainers for KS2
Track suit or joggers and sweatshirt for winter sports

Children need to dress appropriately for PE. A separate bag to contain PE kit is essential. Please mark all kit and the kit bag with your child's name.

For safety reasons all children will be asked to remove watches and either remove or tape ear rings if worn, during PE lessons.

Long hair must be tied up in a band for PE and children should not wear jewellery. Earrings must be either removed or micropore tape must be provided from home to cover them during P.E lessons.

Children who do not bring PE kit to school will be provided with second hand clothing to wear instead.

We ask you that you clearly mark items of clothing with your child's full name. Many items of clothing are identical and it is impossible to trace their owners without clear identification.

Hair should be kept neat and tidy (extreme styles are not acceptable including dyeing or shaved patterns)
Long hair should be retained with sensible accessories in blue, black, or yellow (no large flowers or other adornments).

Jewellery

Children should not wear jewellery to school other than plain small gold/silver stud earrings (no bigger than 5mm). Children may wear sensible watches in Year 5 and 6 but not smart watches.

Other

Children are not permitted to wear makeup, nail varnish or false nails to school.

Lost Property

Storage of lost property is located by the blue gate in the playground. Any unmarked items of school clothing will be left there until the end of each term.

Book Bags

All children enjoy taking books home to share with the family. To protect books we do ask that no book is taken home unless in a suitable folder or bag. Any bags can be used but school book bags for this purpose can be ordered online at Monkhouse.

The Headteacher reserves the right to use his discretion on the Policy and will contact parents should the need arise.
