



Sycamore Class Spring Term 2026



English

This term within their English lessons the children will have the opportunity to write for a range of purposes. We will start off by writing to entertain by creating stories from other cultures. After half term we will write our very own legends and prepare for our poetry slam. Look Who's Talking will also take place this term giving every child the opportunity to speak for two minutes to the class if they wish to.

Topic

For the first part of the term the children will be learning all about the country of Nepal. They will learning a range of geographical facts about the country and explore questions such as 'why is Nepal landlocked?' and 'What is the climate and biomes like in the country?'

During the second half of this term, the children will be participating in a history enquiry: What do all ancient civilisations have in common?

Music

The children will be exploring reggae music including learning how to play and sing the song 'Three Little Birds' by Bob Marley.

Art

In Art, the children will be looking at the work by Nick Cave by exploring a range of different fabrics. They will be using a variety of skills including printing, dyeing, weaving and stitching to create different textural effects.

PE

PE this term will be taught on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. Please ensure your child has a fully named PE kit in school **every week**. In the first half term the children will be preparing for the Dance Festival! Look out for more information.

After half term we will have Forrest School on Tuesday afternoons and on Thursdays we will be having a go at Netball.

Maths

This term the children will be learning to recall their multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 times tables and learning how to multiply and divide numbers using written methods. In the second half of the term the children will be focusing on length, perimeter and fractions.

French

This term the children will continue to learn basic words and phrases in French. We will cover instructions, body part, actions, colours and clothes.

Science

The children will be exploring different types of forces as well as finding out about magnets. This term the children will be focussing on developing their scientific skills of setting up experiments and making sure their tests are fair. In the second half of the term the children will be learning about light.

Computing

This term the children will exploring and creating video trailers.

RE

We will be finding out what it is like to be a Humanist in the UK today. We will also explore diversity by finding out of all Christians believe and behave in the same way.

D&T

In DT the children will be exploring the digital world and creating an electric charm as well as exploring pneumatic toys.

PSHE/Circle Time

The children will take part in weekly sessions focused on the theme of 'Me and My Relationships' and 'Growing and Changing.'
