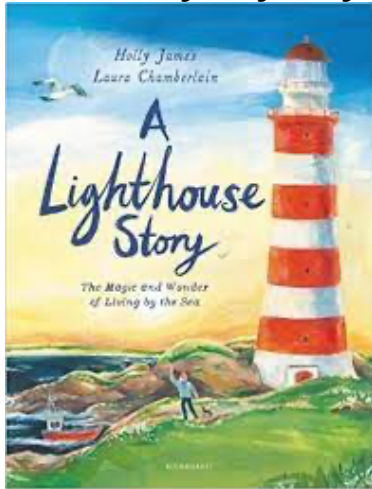
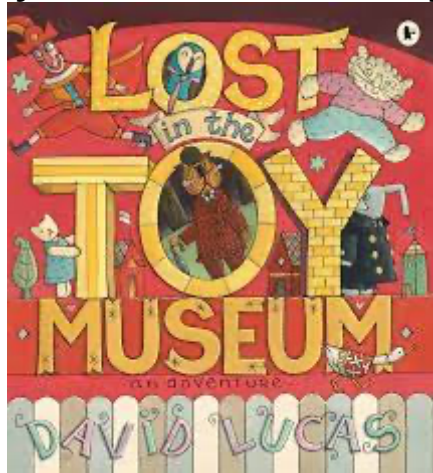
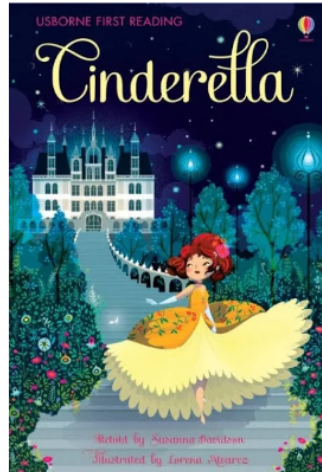
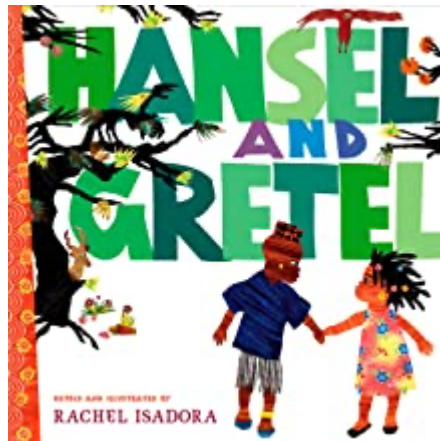
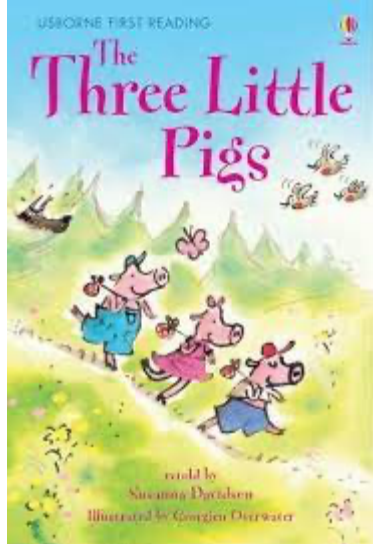
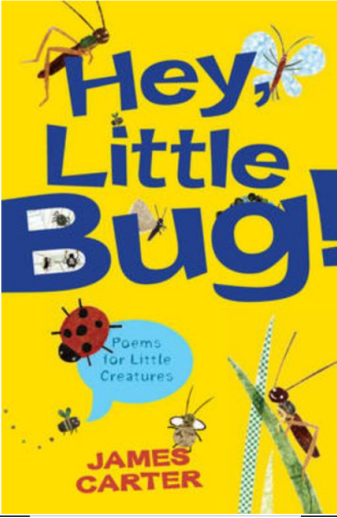


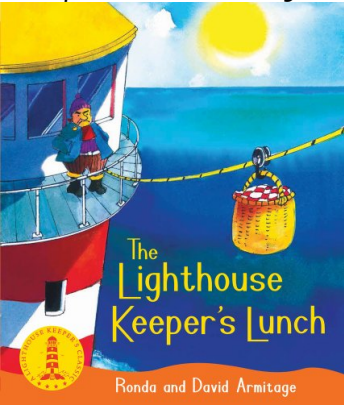
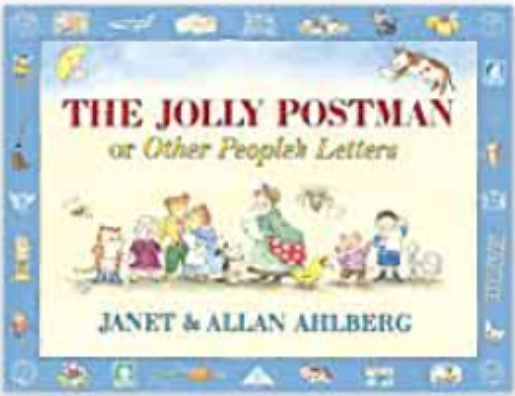
Shurdington Primary School – Reading Spine
